### DID YOU KNOW: (VERY IMPORTANT!!)

Bingo, lottery or other games of chance such as raffles used as fund raisers must give 30 days notice to the county or municipality where the organization intends to conduct the fund raiser? South Dakota Codified Law 22-23-25 is the specific law that governs these kind of fund raisers and should be reviewed prior to conducting a fund raiser.
