- 6. If, for any reason, you find you cannot attend, please notify your sponsoring American Legion Post **and** contact me at the phone/email at bottom of this page as well.
- 7. You will be expected to remain at American Legion Boys State for the entire week, from Monday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, until Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup>.
